Bourgogne Aligoté "En Perthuis" 2020

Planted on limestone soil in 1950, the Aligoté vineyard is situated in Mandelot, Hautes Côtes de Beaune, at an elevation of 400 meters. The yield is 40 hectoliters per hectare.

The Aligoté grapes were harvested on the 11th of September. Upon their arrival at the winery, they were promptly pressed using a horizontal wooden basket press. Subsequently, they were pumped into a tank for 24 hours and cooled down to 10 degrees. Finally, the wine was transferred to 228L barrels. Throughout the entire aging process, we regularly sampled the wines. After 16 months, the wine was ready for racking, placed in a tank for 2 months for homogenization and stabilization, and then prepared for bottling. The first addition of sulphur occurred after the malolactic fermentation, with the second addition right before bottling.
